

Thomas Baubles

3.00mm Hook & 3.50mm Hook

Bauble

Starting with the face and working in the round...

With 3.50mm hook and grey yarn, ch 2

Round 1: 6sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

Round 2: 2sc in each st around (12)

Round 3: *1sc in next st, 2sc in next st* around (18)

Round 4: *1sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st* around (24)

Round 5: *1sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st* around (30)

Rounds 6-7: Sc around (30)

In last st of round 7 change to black yarn.

Round 8: In BLO, sc around (30)

Rounds 9-10: Sc around (30)

In last st of round 10 change to blue yarn (or whatever colour your train is).

Round 11: Sc around (30)

Round 12: *Sc2tog, 1sc in next 3 st* around (24)

Round 13: *Sc2tog, 1sc in next 2 st* around (18)

Round 14: *Sc2tog, 1sc in next st* around (12)

Stuff the bauble.

Round 15: Sc2tog around (6)

Cut the yarn with about 15cm to spare, pull the yarn through the loop, and then sew up hole.

Eyes x 2

With 3.00mm hook and white yarn, ch 2

Round 1: 8sc in 2nd ch from hook (8)

FO

With 3.00mm hook and black yarn, ch 2

Round 1: 4sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

FO

Nose

With 3.00mm hook and grey yarn, ch 2

Round 1: 8sc in 2nd ch from hook (8)

Round 2: Sc around (8)

FO

Chimney

With 3.00mm hook and black yarn, ch 2

Round 1: 6sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

Round 2a: In FLO, 2sc in each st around (12)

Round 2b: Now, working out of BLO from Round 1, sc around (6)

Round 3: Sc around (6)

FO

Putting it all together

Sew the nose on first in the middle of the face.

You can sew up the eyes separately and then sew them on the face, or sew on the white part, then the black, and then add a French knot.

Add some eyebrows and a mouth.

Sew the chimney on top.

Get a bit of thread to sew under the chimney to tie up so it can hang from the tree.
